Which said marijuana is classified as a controlled dangerous substance in Schedule I of the Controlled Dangerous Substance Act of this State, contrary to the provisions of Section 2-401(G) of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

- COUNT(S) 1, 3, 5: Manufacturing a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana) Imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for not less than seven (7) years nor more than life and by a fine of not less than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00), which shall be in addition to other punishment provided by law and shall not be imposed in lieu of other punishment. 63 O.S. § 2-401(G)
- COUNT(S) 2, 4, 6: Trafficking in Illegal Drugs (Marijuana) Imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections not to exceed twenty (20) years and a fine of not less than Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) and not more than One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00). 63 O.S. § 2-415(D)(1).
- COUNT(S) 7: Pattern of Criminal Offenses Imprisonment for a term not to exceed two (years) in the Department of Corrections, or one (1) year in the County Jail, and/or \$25,000.00 fine. 21 O.S. §425(A).
