COUNT 1: MANUFACTURING A CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE, TO WIT: MARIJUANA ~ 63 O.S. § 2–401(G), a FELONY

COUNT 2: TRAFFICKING OF A CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE, TO WIT: IN EXCESS OF TWENTY-FIVE POUNDS OF MARIJUANA ~ 63 O.S. § 2-415(C)(1)(a), a FELONY

IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

COUNT 1: MANUFACTURING A CONTROLLED DANGEROUS SUBSTANCE, TO WIT: MARIJUANA ~ 63 O.S. § 2–401(G), a FELONY

On or about July 25, 2023, the crime of manufacturing marijuana plants from which a controlled dangerous substance is derived was committed by YIFAN LU, who knowingly aided, promoted, or encouraged others, both known and unknown to the Grand Jury, to manufacture, cultivate, and/or produce a species of plant from which a controlled dangerous substance is derived, to wit: marijuana at Green Panda Cultivation Inc., 146 Sunshine Road, McAlester, Pittsburg County, Oklahoma. Which said marijuana is classified as a controlled dangerous substance in Schedule I of the Controlled Dangerous Substance Act of this State, contrary to the provisions of Section 2–401(G) of Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Oklahoma.

COUNT(S) 1: Manufacturing a Controlled Dangerous Substance (Marijuana) – Imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for not less than seven (7) years nor more than life and by a fine of not less than Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00), which shall be in addition to other punishment provided by law and shall not be imposed in lieu of other punishment. 63 O.S. § 2-401(G)

COUNT(S) 2: Trafficking in Illegal Drugs (Marijuana) - Imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections not to exceed twenty (20) years and a fine of not less than Twenty-five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000.00) and not more than One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000.00). 63 O.S. § 2-415(D)(1).
